Some things to know as we head into Term 2...

Lunches/Drink bottles/Hats

Please send a packed lunch to school each day. Each child will also need a named drink bottle that can stay at school during the week and be refilled each day. We will send these home on Fridays to be washed. As we head into cooler weather, the children can use their school beanie. These will be handed out to students in the next week or so and will be kept in their bags when not in use.

Maths

This term we will be focussing on Measurement, Number Knowledge and Number Strategies. Our Measurement focus will include length, volume/capacity, mass/weight, area, time and temperature. We encourage you to look for fun ways to explore these things with your child. Some ideas are: using a measuring cup to do some cooking together, looking at the weight or capacity of different items in the supermarket, timing the length of different activities, measuring things and using measuring language: (long/short, fast, slow, big, small, heavy, light etc) The possibilities are numerous! We continue to explore numbers to 100 and +/- strategies with our learners. Counting forwards and backwards is a great thing to do as you drive or walk somewhere with your child!

Reading

All children will be reading regularly with a teacher. Books will be sent home in a book bag on a Tuesday and Thursday. Please take time to read this together. It is vital that book bags and books come back to school the following day. Our school reading books are very precious! On Friday a Poem Book will come home with a poem for you to read and enjoy with your child. Please return this the following Monday.

Inquiry/Learning Through Play

We continue to prioritise Learning Through Play where children can explore their interests and passions within a range of curriculum areas. This term we will also be focussing on the Matariki celebration in June, along with book related activities as part of Featherston Booktown.
